

Gospel Meditation

How is it that you came in here without a wedding garment? (*Matthew* 22:12)

In Scripture, the image of a wedding garment is used to represent the essential elements of our life in Christ - a garment of salvation, obedience, and of purity. Now, if we were to apply this parable to the Mass, we face this question every Sunday: "Have I come to the Eucharistic feast with my heart properly dressed? Or have I come without thinking about how eating the Bread of Life is meant to help me change my heart?" Today and every Sunday, let's remind ourselves that the Mass is a wonderful precursor to the great wedding banquet that will come when Jesus return in glory. Let's remember that if we keep our garment on now, we'll be clothed in Christ at the end!
